QantasLink's Western Australia-based regional operation, Network Aviation, is acquiring up to 14 mid-life Embraer E190s, progressively replacing its Fokker F100 fleet.

The new fleet will be refurbished with all new seats and Wi-Fi to stream inflight entertainment. The first E190 aircraft will enter commercial service from January 2027.*
